## Buy your cannas as bulbs or potted plants!



Order your bulbs for shipment from mid-February through the month of June. Order your plants for shipment between the months of May and July. Bulbs are shipped fresh and healthy with a minimum of three to five eyes each. A sample size bulb is pictured left. Plants are shipped in 1.2 quart containers that measure about $4 \times 4 \times 5$ inches. A sample size of our plants is pictured right. Plants range in height from 12 to 24 " tall, depending on the time of year they are shipped.

## Caring for Your Cannas

Cannas are herbaceous perennials native to the northern and southern hemisphere. Cannas grow beautifully throughout the United States, flourishing with plenty of heat and water. Cannas are very dependable; easy to plant and easy to grow.

## Planting

Canna rhizomes may be planted in the spring after danger from frost. Plant cannas when soil temperatures have warmed to 60 degrees or warmer. Best results are achieved when planted in loose, fertile and well-draining soil. Cannas love full sun and require a minimum of four hours of direct sunlight.
Plant bulbs (rhizomes) 12 to 18 inches apart. Lay the long part of the rhizome horizontal to the earth's surface with eye up, if visible. This is not critical, as cannas will grow no matter which direction they are planted.

## Summer Care

Cannas typically bloom 90 days from the planting date. Cannas should be watered thoroughly several times a week by slowly soaking the area around roots. Water more often during the heat of the summer. Cannas are heavy feeders. Apply 5-10-5 or 10-10-10 fertilizer two or three times during the growing season for added performance. Although cannas will continue to bloom if not dead-headed, cutting spent flowers and seed pods will keep flowerbeds looking tidy.

## Overwintering

Cannas multiply producing three to five new rhizomes for each one planted. Dig clumps of bulbs in the late fall or after the first frost for re-planting the following spring. The most common mistake is allowing the canna rhizomes to dry out too much while in storage.
Rhizomes can be washed, then divided and layered with vermiculite or peat moss in plastic bags. A few air holes around the sides will help give a small amount of needed air flow. Store in a basement or other cool place such as a cool corner of a garage, under the house, cellar, etc.

Cannas are best planted in warm ground covered with one to two inches of soil. Water cannas well at planting. They require little to no water until cannas begin sprouting. Cannas are slow to sprout, sometimes taking three weeks to break through the soil surface. After sprouting, begin regular watering several times a week.
In colder regions, (6-8 weeks before spring), bulbs can be planted in pots and placed in greenhouse conditions. When danger of frost is past, remove from pot and plant outside.

Cultivate often to keep soil loose and free of weeds and grass.
Leaf feeding insects and leaf rolling caterpillars can be stopped by regular applications of bT. Other products include systemic insecticides with an active ingredient of $97.4 \%$ acephate as well as garlic barrier insect repellant. Neem oil products are also helpful in removing leafrollers. It is best to treat cannas very early in the season to control canna leaf rollers. Be certain to apply the treatment to the soil near your cannas as well as the foliage.

Rhizomes must not be allowed to freeze during storage. The ideal storage temperature is 50 degrees.

IN WARMER CLIMATES (zone 7-10) where the ground does not freeze below four to six inches, cannas can be left in the ground all winter. For zone 7, cut foliage down to the ground and cover flowerbed with six to twelve inches of grass clippings, leaves, compost, hay straw, etc. Cannas in zones 8-10 do not require mulch for winter protection. Cannas can be thinned in the spring every two to three years by digging out thick areas of bulbs to allow spacing between the plants.
